LECTURES Each presentation will be given to a group of 50–90 people and will last one hour. Each presentation will be given twice. Topics may include all aspects of working with PMC (surfaces, construction, firing, finishing, etc.) and related techniques such as enameling, bead making, polymer clay, etc. We will also consider topics of interest to our members such as marketing, invention, safety, photography, and teaching. We are discouraging presentations that focus on a single person and those that are primarily associated with a commercial product.

TECH EXPO This venue was premiered in 2008 and will expanded and improved this year. These tabletop presentations are ideal for technical information because they allow viewers to determine their depth of involvement. Presentations include samples, sequence photos, illustrations, posters, and computer animations. Presentations are available for conferees for more than 20 hours, allowing revisits and discussion. Each presenter is asked to be at the table for at least three hours during the conference. There will also be an opportunity for demonstrations in a nearby space.
