## PRE-CONFERENCE WORKSHOP

### **Instant Earrings!** **Barbara Becker Simon**

One Day Workshop, June 20, 2012  
Cost per Student: **\$190.00**

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There is no limit to the form these earrings can take. Using PMC paper and fine silver wire, students will see how simple it is to construct beautiful, lightweight earrings in an instant. They can be adorned with half-drilled gem balls or pearls or fully drilled pearls or beads. A couple basic designs will be demonstrated, so that once the technique is mastered, students may make as many pairs as their supply of paper, wire and time will allow!

Class limit: 15 students. This class is for students of all skill levels.

#### **Tools and Materials Provided**

The instructor will provide all tools and equipment to complete the project with the exception of the tools and supplies brought by the students, listed below.

#### **Tools that Students Should Bring**

- PMC+ Paper, any shape, 2 or more packages
- 1 jar PMC paste
- 2 feet of 20 gauge, round, fine silver wire
- Container for water
- Paper and Pencil
- Sharpie black magic marker
- Ruler
- Scissors
- Craft knife
- Flush cutters
- Round nose pliers
- Chain nose pliers
- Paint brush
- 2 Teflon sheets, approx. 8 cm X 8 cm
- Work surface- plastic or glass sheet
- Earring findings  
(I prefer sterling ear wires but your choice on this!)

A kit with 4 half-drilled pearls will be provided for each student, as part of the class fee. (I will also have extra pearls to purchase.) However, if students want to bring more pearls or beads for adornment, here are the specifics:

Optional: Half-drilled pearls or half-drilled gem balls, size: 4mm - 5.5 mm diameter

OR

Fully drilled pearls or beads, size: 4mm - 5.5 mm diameter

*Note: Holes in the pearls and beads must be able to fit on a 20 gauge wire.*
