Description

In this workshop you'll learn the basics of working with ring design and construction in PMC Sterling. We'll focus on forming, carving, sizing, and firing both seamed and seamless rings. Other topics demonstrated and discussed include hinges, openwork, and lightweight hollow forms.

The class fee includes

Sandpaper, finishing supplies and other consumables, Teflon paper (to work on), sheet protectors (to work under), water and oil, share tools, share texture, share carvers, sterling and brass wire, polymer (to practice carving), patina supplies, firing, shipping, and handouts.

Supply List - please bring

- PMC Sterling (25-50 grams)
- Slip (homemade)
- Work surface (plastic placemat, a cutting matt, plexiglass, etc.)
- Deck of playing cards
- Rolling tool
- Watercolor brush
- Palette knife (for mixing slip)
- Pin tool
- Tissue blade or other long cutting blade
- X-Acto type knife
- Additional Teflon sheet
- Graph paper
- Paper and pencil
- any other favorite tools, and textures

Note: If you bring a work light please bring an extension cord and tape (to tape it onto the floor)

Bring if you can

Chain-nosed pliers, ring mandrel, bench block, rawhide mallet, hammer, paper and pencil, mm gauge, carving tools, nylon-jaw pliers, scissors.
