Hinged Keepsake Pendant **Terry Kovalcik**

Two Day Workshop,

Skill level: Determined Beginner / Intermediate

In this class we will explore the process of making a hinged keepsake pendant that can hold something close your heart. Learn to create a beautiful hollow form and transform it into a hinged locket with a hasp-style closure made from various types of PMC. Some of the techniques we will examine include pattern making, dry construction, rolling textures, hinges, cold connection (reiveting), catch mechanism, and finishing.

Students Should Bring

- 45 grams (or more) of PMC+
- PMC3 Slip (not necessarily a full jar)
- 9 grams of PMC3
- 1 sheet of PMC Paper (for hinges and details)
- PMC3 syringe (optional)
- Pad for notes and sketching
- Small covered container (e.g. Altoid box) to protect work in transit.
- Rubber tipped blending tool
- Watercolor brush, 0 or 00 size, good quality (Windsor Newton is a good brand)
- Larger, moderately priced brush for general utility

Basic Tool Kit – \$25 (available for purchase at the class)

If you are NOT purchasing a basic tool kit, bring these tools yourself

- Playing cards (10-25)
- Work surface (styrene, acrylic, Teflon, etc.)
- Sharp needle tool
- Small spray bottle for water
- Salon Boards, fine and medium grit
- 1 sheet each of 400 and 600 grit sandpaper
- X-Acto knife with #11 blade
- Several single edge razor blades
- Plastic roller

- Jewelers sawframe with small blades
- Steel block
- Hammer to flatten wire
- Pin files
- Riveting hammer

- Your favorite texture plates
- Dental tools
- Magnifiers
